- 4) The application must be complete and the information mentioned in the registration form should be true. In case of any discrepancy, management holds the right to cancel the registration form as well as the admission of the Candidates.
- 5) It is compulsory for students to appear for an interview along with both parents on the scheduled date.
- 6) The following documents have to be submitted along with the admission form at the time of registration.
 - i. Photocopy of the progress Card attested by the principal.
 - ii. Photocopy of Aadhar Card issued in the name of the child (Original for verification)
 - iii. Photocopy of residence Certificate
 - iv. Photocopy of Community Certificate of Father
