


Conclusion: Earth, a unique system supporting diverse life is connected to our well-being. Protecting it is crucial for the future of all life.

COLOSSAL WORLD OF SOCIAL SCIENCE






Unsung heroes



Let's learn how to Make an Origami Fish



- *Materials Needed:*
 - A square sheet of paper 6
 - Markers
- *Steps:*
- 1. Start with a square sheet of paper.
- 2. Fold the paper diagonally to form a triangle. Crease the fold well and then unfold it.
- 3. Fold the paper along the other diagonal to form another triangle.
- 4. Fold the paper horizontally to form a rectangle.
- 5. Push the left and right sides of the square towards each other, collapsing the paper into a triangle shape.
- 6. With the triangle base pointing down, fold one of the lower corners of the triangle up to the top to form the fish's tail. Repeat the fold with the other lower corner, overlapping the first fold.
- 7. Fold the two tail flaps outward along the edges to give the fish a broader shape.
- 8. Use markers to draw eyes and scales on your fish to make it more realistic.




Interschool Yoga Competition 2024



FINANCIAL LITERACY AWARENESS QUIZ

To gauge the level of financial awareness among our school students, Our VFFA(Vaasavi Fiduciary Finacial Associates) Club recently conducted a financial literacy survey among students from Class 6 to 10. The questionnaire was thoughtfully designed to cover the key aspects of financial literacy like (savings and banking knowledge, investment budgeting, awareness, and taxes). The results showed that the banking and financial knowledge among the students is modest as only 78% understood the importance of saving, only 40% knew how to create a budget, and just 18% were familiar with investments like stocks and other related terms.
